It is a service to victims of child abuse, rape, spouse abuse, and adult victims of crimes against the person. This is a special division of the County Prosecutor's Office. It is their primary goal to assist persons who have been victimized by crime in Sandusky County. Their goal is to help victims of crime understand the criminal justice system and address any questions or concerns that may arise in the aftermath of a crime. The staff is available to assist victims and/or their families.

The Sandusky County Victim Assistance Program provides advocacy to victims of felony offenses, assists with Menacing and Stalking Civil Protection Orders, and is responsible for administering the program. It also provides services to female victims of domestic violence, and services to victims of juvenile offenders.
